

Author guidelines

1. General

1.1 About RTeJournal

RTeJournal is a freely accessible e-journal that publishes articles from the field of generative manufacturing technology in German or English. All submitted manuscripts are formally checked by the editorial team and undergo a peer review process before publication.

1.2 Licensing

The author guidelines follow the guidelines of the Digital Peer Publishing Licence of the ministry of science and research of the state of North Rhine-Westphalia. All contributions are published without remuneration for the author. The costs of publication are borne by RTeJournal, the author incurs no costs. There is no entitlement to publication.

2. Legal requirements for publication

2.1 Author contract

By signing the author contract, the main author accepts the guidelines of RTeJournal. The author contract is signed by the main author and submitted via upload on the RTeJournal website.

2.2 Authorship

The main author confirms in the author's contract that he/she holds the copyrighted rights of use to his/her work and the supplied text and image templates, and that the rights of use granted to RTeJournal do not conflict with any other rights. All named authors assure that they have contributed with a substantial part to the creation of the article and that they agree with the form and content of the manuscript. If material (e.g., figures or tables) from other sources is included, the author must have permission for publication in the RTeJournal.

2.3 Author rights

There is no transfer of copyright from the author to RTeJournal. The author, as the originator of the scientific work, continues to hold all rights to his or her work; however, in the event of further publication, a first publication notice must be added.

2.4 Granting of rights

In the event of publication, the author grants RTeJournal the right to reproduce the contribution in electronic form without any temporal or spatial restrictions, to transmit it to third parties by electronic means and - by making it available for download - to make it publicly accessible. RTeJournal is also entitled to include the contribution in electronic databases or other collections and to store it for an unlimited period. All other exploitation rights of the author are not restricted. The rights for use in physical form, in particular the rights for distribution in print or on carrier media, remain with the author or other rights holder.

Publication guidelines

1. Languages

Manuscripts are submitted in german or english.

2. Length of the contributions

The manuscript should not exceed 6 pages. The wording should correspond to the medium and contain predominantly short, clear sentence structures.

3. Bibliographic information

The title is given on the first page of the manuscript. This is followed by the surnames and first names of all authors involved and the institutions for which they work.

4. Abstract and Keywords

The paper should be preceded by a German and an English abstract (max. 1000 characters). This is followed by appropriate keywords, which should represent the essential content of the entire contribution.

The translation of the abstract and keywords into the other language can be done by the author himself/herself.

5. Outline and formatting

The content is divided into subheadings, text paragraphs and, if applicable, lists/tables or graphics. Figures and tables are provided with legends and numbered consecutively. The specified format must be used. If the format is not adhered to, the paper will be formally rejected. An immediate resubmission with a changed format is desired in this case.

6. Bibliography / Citation

The literature cited in the text is listed in the bibliography. The literature citations in the text, tables and legends are given a consecutive number in the order in which they appear. At the end of the article, a list of the corresponding references is given under the relevant number. The bibliography is numbered in the order of citation in the text and not alphabetically.

Exact citation examples can be downloaded from the site.

7. Contact details

At the end of the article there are contact details. In addition to the name of the author, these contain the institution for which the author works and an e-mail address. The author agrees to the publication of this data in the author contract.

8. Text and graphic formats

Entries are submitted digitally via the website. Only searchable PDF files are accepted as file format.
